If you are not familiar with or have never used Studio 180 Design tools, then you are in for a treat, because once you use these tools you will never want to go back. Studio 180 Design tools are the perfect choice for new quilters to advanced quilters. So, if you struggle with chopped off points, wonky blocks, and your stitch ripper feels like it could be your best friend, then class is for you!

This introductory class has two segments:

### Part 1- Technique: Learning the Tucker Trimmer III Tool

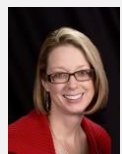
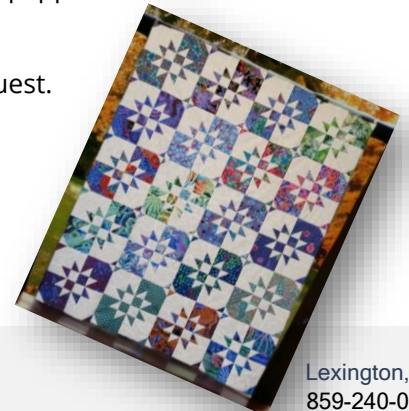
The first 3 hours of this class will focus on learning and using the Tucker Trimmer to make precision half square triangles, combination units, and hourglass units. These units are practice units and are great stash busters.

### Part 2- Project: Hocus Pocus Quilt

Put your Tucker Trimmer into real life practice by using it to make a Hocus Pocus Quilt. This quilt comes together like 'magic' and is easier to make than it looks. That is where 'hocus pocus' comes into play, but we cannot give away all the secrets behind how to make this quilt. Register and see for yourself how simple this quilt is to make. Better yet, it can be layout in several unique design patterns giving you more options so that it feels like a new quilt pattern every time! You will be amazed how quickly this one comes together!

After attending this class, the Tucker Trimmer will become your "go to" tool for squaring blocks and perfectly centering hourglass units, combination blocks and more. You will leave with the confidence you need so that you do not end up with another tool that sits on a shelf collecting dust because you do not know how to use it. Plus, you leave equipped with how to make a beautiful Hocus Pocus quilt!

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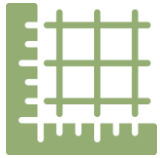

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### Studio 180 Design Tools:

- Tucker Trimmer III
- Quilters Magic Wand (Optional)

### Cutting Instructions

#### Part 1– Learning the Tucker Trimmer III Tool



#### Half Square Triangle 4" Finished

- Fabric A Cut (2) 5" x 5" squares
- Fabric B Cut (2) 5" x 5" squares



#### Combination Units 4" Finished

- Fabric A (2) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares
- Fabric B (2) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares
- Fabric C (4) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares



#### Hourglass Units 4" Finished

- Fabric A (4) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares
- Fabric B (4) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares

#### Part 2 – Hocus Pocus

##### Light Fabric:

- 2 3/4 yards cut into 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" squares

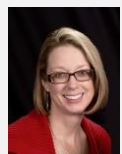
##### Mediums & Dark Fabrics

- 40- 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" squares\*

\*10 Fat quarters or fabrics of your choice

### Basic Sewing Supplies

- Sewing Machine with power cords
- Thread (white and a color to coordinate with your applique fabric)
- Machine needles
- Snips or trimming scissors
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
- Erasable Marking Pencil
- Small cutting mat
- Straight edge ruler 6" x 24"
- Invisi-grip (optional but recommended)



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
